New Education Policy 2025-26

As of June 2025 no new education policy (NEP 2024 or NEP 2025) has been officially announced anywhere so far.

NEP 2020 is still the current and active education policy today Under this policy new changes (such as two board exams in a year, flexible subject choice, new curriculum etc) are being introduced and applied.

2023 to 2025 the process of implementing it is being reviewed by the ministry and national level committees carefully and regularly now However for any "new NEP" no new chairman has been appointed yet because right now no such new policy has actually been created or announced.

Dr. K. Kasturirangan is still considered the Main Architect of the present NEP (2020) and his committee's work is still being implemented across the country.

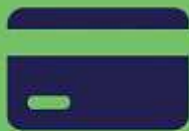

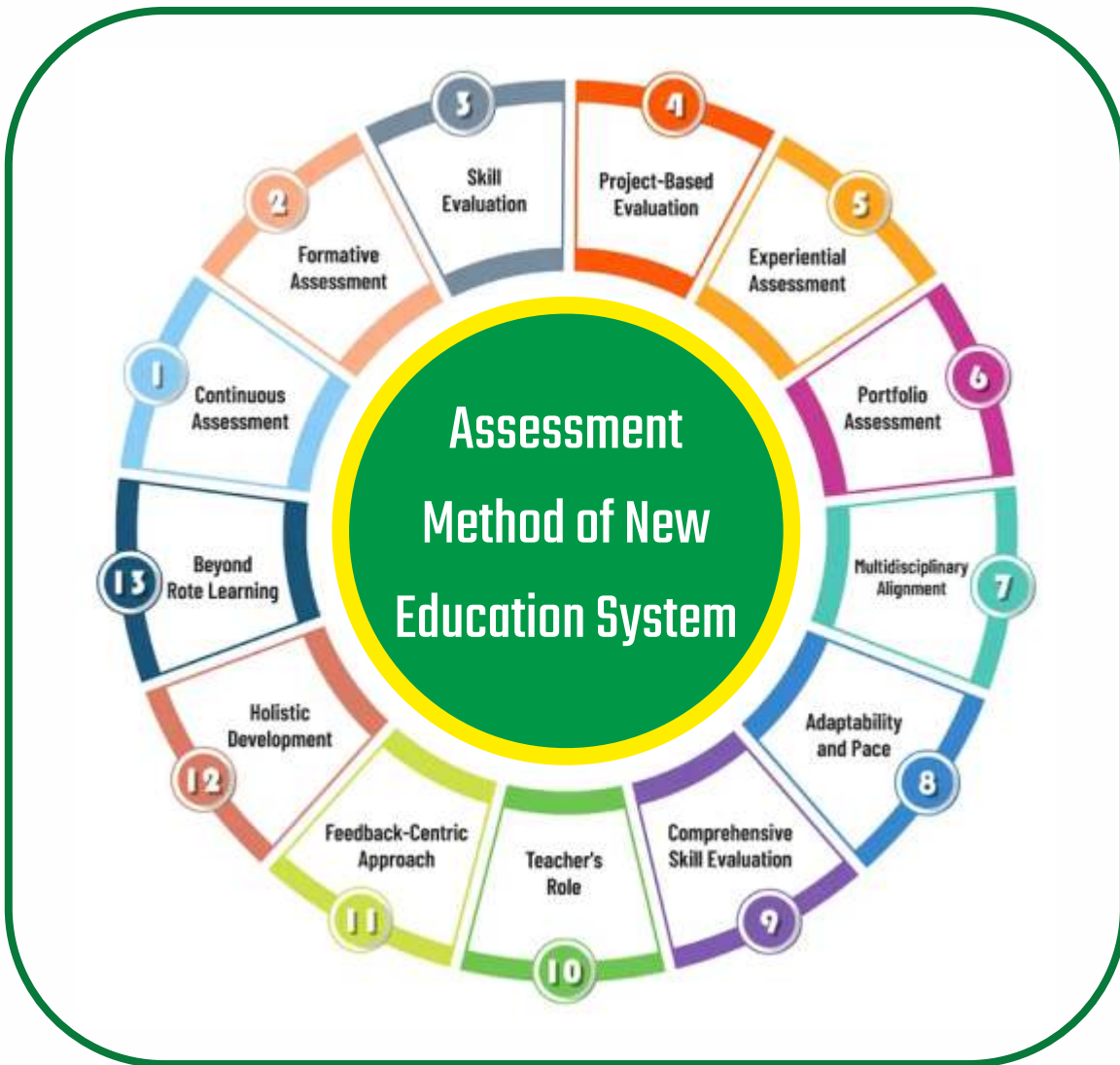

What is NSQF?

- It is a framework of the Government of India managed by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship
- In this system skill training and educational programs are divided from Level 1 to Level 10. Level 1 – Most basic entry level Level 10 – Highest level (equal to PhD or Doctorate)

Meaning of NSQF certified for students

- The course is recognized across India

Origin & Evolution

- Before 1858, it was called East India Company's Civil Service
- It was also known as Covenanted Civil Service (for British officials only)
- In 1858, after British Crown took control, it became Indian Civil Service (ICS)
- Post-1947 (after independence), ICS was renamed as IAS (Indian Administrative Service) under the All India Services Act, 1951
- UPSC (Union Public Service Commission) was officially formed on October 1, 1926

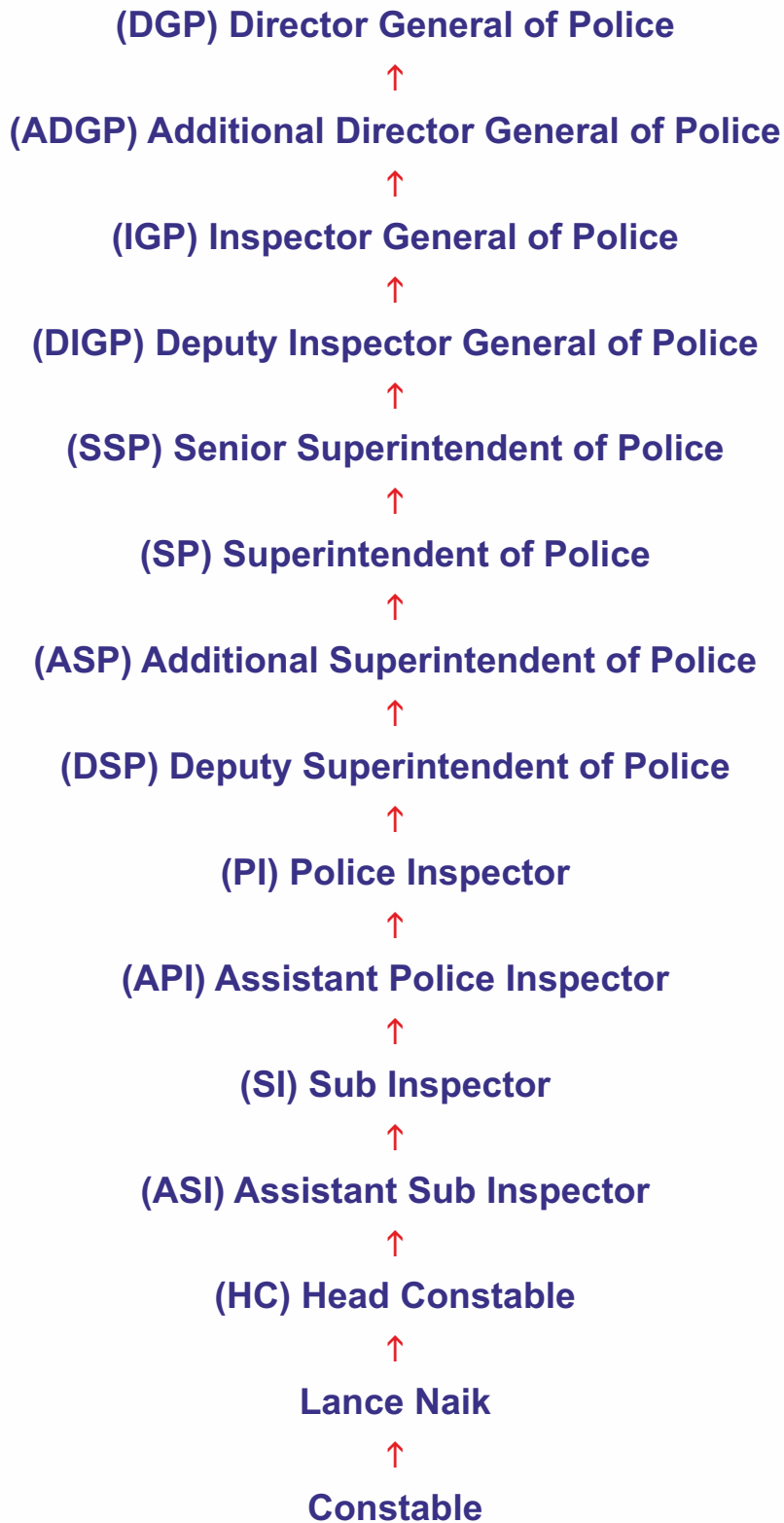

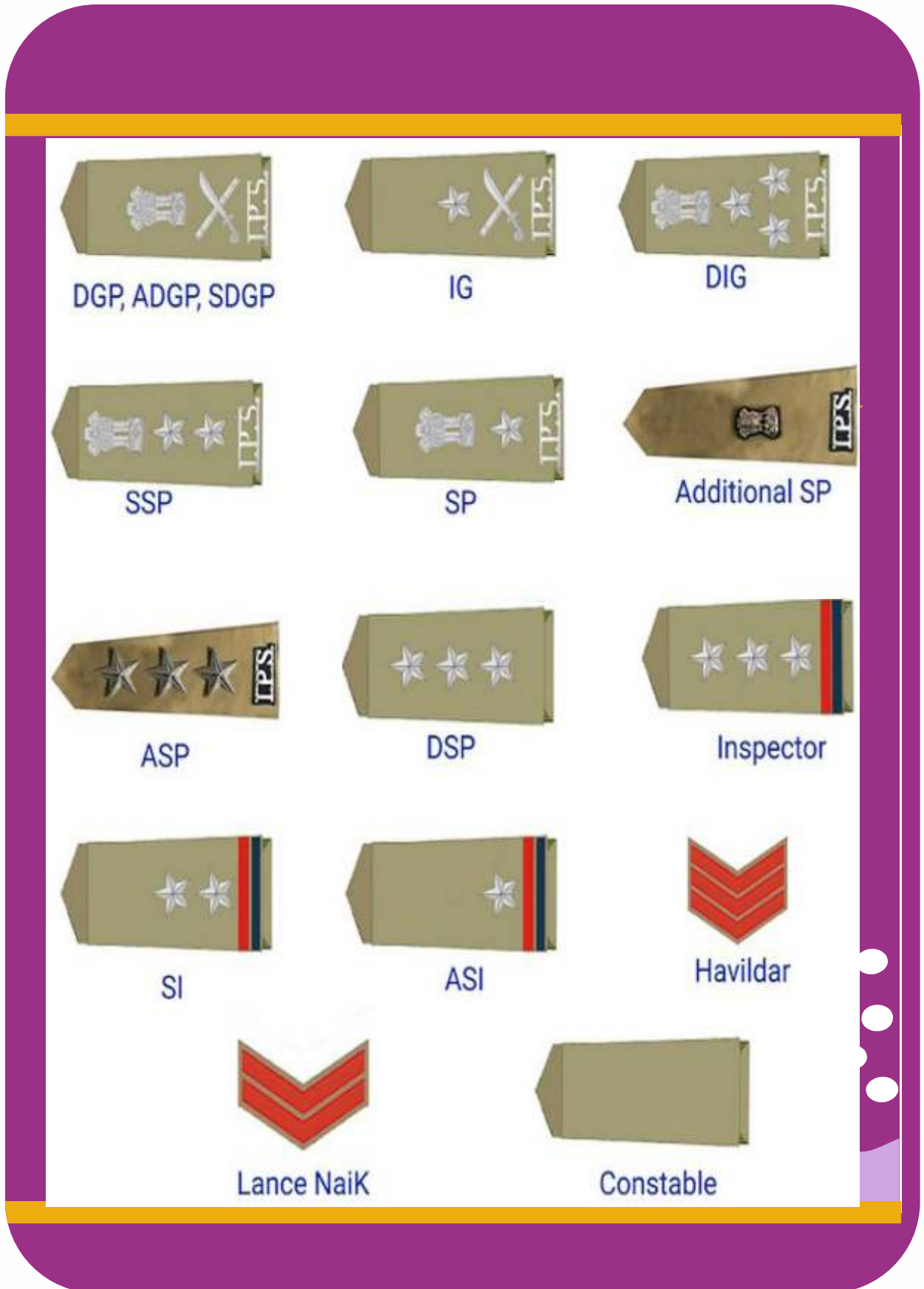


Police Designation at a Glance
